Heartland Center for Spirituality "Theology Institute on Integral Ecology"

July 21-25

Heartland Center for Spirituality will be having a Theology Institute on Integral Ecology July 21-25. Linda Gibler, OP will present on Pope Francis' encyclical, Laudato Si'. In the encyclical Pope Francis calls for a renewed exploration of what it means to be human in relationship to a suffering planet. In this Theological Institute, we will explore what the Earth, Laudato Si', and our faith tradition might be asking of us. In our days together, we will take an ecological look at key passages in the Bible, explore cosmocentric perspectives on Sacraments, Prayer, and Preaching, and ask ourselves how our gifts and charisms (personal and communal) call us to respond to an "Integral Ecology."

Linda, a Dominican Sister of Houston, is the Associate Academic Dean of the Oblate School of Theology in San Antonio. She also lectures and gives workshops on the significance of recent scientific discoveries for Catholic theology and spirituality. Her book, From the Beginning to Baptism: Scientific and Sacred Stories of Water, Oil and Fire was published in 2010 by Liturgical Press.

J.A.M. Session with your DRE July 9, 2016

14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Sunday Gospel: **Matthew 11:25-30**

Sometimes grownups seem very clever, as if they know all the answers. Today Jesus tells us that it wasn't always the clever people who first understood him. Often it was those who had childlike hearts.

Side note to from your DRE!!!

Jesus once said, "Do not keep the little children away from me! Only those who are like them will enter the kingdom of God." (Matthew 19:13-15) None of us stays a child forever; each of us will grow up and become an adult. Jesus was telling us that he wanted us to keep the childlike qualities of goodness as we become grownups. Remember some of the features of a small child: trust, honesty, love, innocence, and simplicity. If we have these qualities as children of God, we will stay close to God's love and never wander from his friendship. What did Jesus tell us to do with our cares and troubles? Just as a young child has complete faith and trust in his or her parents, so we can rely on God. We can share our problems and worries, and know that we can depend on God to love and take care of us.
