### The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

#### **Sunday Gospel: John 6:51-58**

Today Jesus tells the people that he is "the bread of Life" and that anyone who eats this bread will live forever.

#### **Side note from your DRE!!!**

Bread is made with flour which comes from wheat that has been found and milled. At the bakery, it is mixed with yeast to make it rise before it is baked and sold. Jesus described himself as the bread of life which had come down from heaven. He said that whoever ate this bread would share everlasting life with God at the end of time. The people didn't understand what Jesus told them. Some thought what Jesus told them to eat his flesh, others were confused because he told them that he came down from heaven. But they knew that he was the son of Joseph and Mary. Still they were confused because he offered them the gift of eternal life, and did not understand how this could happen. Do you find what Jesus said confusing? Sometimes when we find something confusing it becomes clear after we have really listened from start to finish. We know the end of today's story said, "Whoever eats the bread of life will live forever." Jesus promised that if we eat the bread which he gives, the gift of himself, then he will fill us with his life, and at the end of time, we will rise from the dead and live with him forever in heaven.
