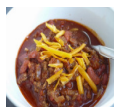

New Food Bank information

Senior Food Box Program to being in Barton County. The Kansas Food Bank with local partners Food Bank of Barton County, Barton County Health Department, RSVP, Hoisington Food Bank, St. Rose Health Center, United Way, Eldercare, Inc. and Central Kansas Partnership are introducing a USDA program to help provide monthly food boxes to low income seniors. The program is available to person-age 60 and above, who qualify by meeting monthly income requirements. Distribution will start in February. Interested seniors must fill out an application and provide the following: proof of ID, proof of income (Social Security Statement), and proof of address. Once approved, they will receive a monthly box and will recertify in six months. **The Kansas Food Bank will be scheduling appointments in Great Bend at the RSVP office at 1025 Main on Wednesday, January 10, 2018 between 10 am and 4 pm to register.** To schedule an appointment, call Debi at the Kansas Food Bank at 316-265-3663. (Food packages include a variety of foods, such as nonfat dry and ultra high temperature fluid milk, juice, farina, oats, ready-to-eat cereal, rice, pasta, peanut butter, dry beans, canned meat, poultry or fish, and canned fruits & vegetables.)
