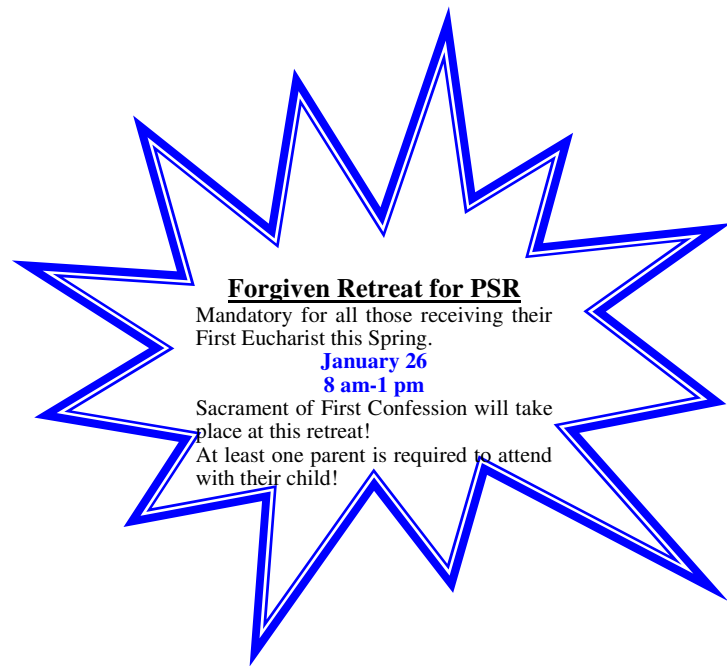

Scripture Course on the New Testament

You are invited to participate in a course that Fr. Reggie Urban, a semi-retired priest of the Dodge City Diocese now living in Hays, will be teaching about the 27 books of the New Testament. The 9 classes will take place on Saturday mornings from 8:30 am until 12 noon beginning January 19th and going until March 16th at 17 different ITV (interactive TV) sites. You can take this course for 3 hours of college credit (\$150) or for enrichment (\$75). The cost does not include the textbook, An Introduction To the New Testament by Fr.
