At the **5:00 pm Mass next Saturday (February 9), at the worship site at St. Patrick**, we will celebrate the Rite of Acceptance for the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA). This Rite is meant to give those who are unbaptized and have been known as Inquirers the opportunity to formally announce that they wish to receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, & Eucharist) in the Catholic Church. After this Rite, they become known as *Catechumens* and will continue their endeavor towards Christ until initiation at the Easter Vigil.

Rite of Welcome (RCIA)

At the **10:00 am Mass next Sunday (February 10), at the worship site at St. Rose**, we will celebrate the Rite of Welcome for the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA). This Rite is meant to give those who are baptized in another Christian denomination or Catholics who never completed the Sacraments of Initiation the opportunity to formally announce that they wish to complete the Sacraments of Initiation (Confirmation & Eucharist) in the Catholic church, thus coming into full communion with the church. After this Rite, they become known as *Candidates* and will continue their endeavor towards Christ until initiation at the Easter Vigil or another appropriate Sunday Liturgy.

Why Be a Catechist?

"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age." Matthew 28:19-20



Do you love your faith that you want to pass it on to our future church? Do you want to encounter Christ in a new way and learn more about your faith? Is God calling you to do more than just be in the pews on Sunday?

The 2019-20 school year is fast approaching and although it is still in a far off distance, I am beginning my search for catechists for PSR and Confirmation.

Over the next 10 weeks, I will have a series called "Why Be a Catechist?"

To start off, we need to define what a *catechist* is. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, *Catechesis* is an education of children, young people, and adults in the faith of the Church through the teaching of Christian doctrine in an organic and systematic way to make them disciples of Jesus Christ. Those who perform the ministry of catechesis in the church are called "*catechists*".

Thank you to the Great Bend Knights of Columbus for hosting our dinner this year...the food, the atmosphere, and the service was outstanding!

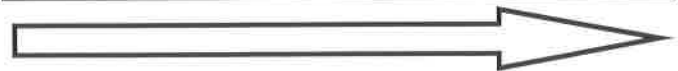
