Prayer & Action is basically a mission trip in your own backyard. Instead of going around the world to serve those in need, youth stay here, in the Diocese of Dodge City. College students and high school youth serve others by helping those in need with various projects. They encounter Christ by serving others and through the Sacraments. Finally, they love the end results and those they served and met.

The first time I went to Prayer & Action was last summer. My wife & daughter encouraged me to go so I could see what Prayer & Action was all about. The Catholic Diocese of Dodge City wanted to see more dads get involved in this program, so I told myself that maybe it was time for me to practice what I preached to my children when I tell them to participate in church activities.

I recommend this experience to other parents and youth. For me it was one of the best times I spent my vacation days on, plus it was so inexpensive. 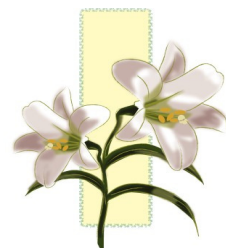

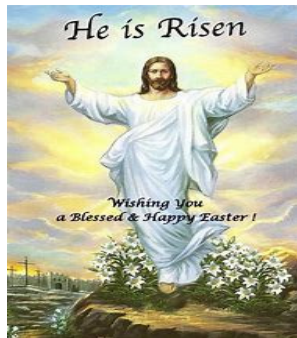
